

# “Who Sez So!?” ... The 10 Commandments

*Exodus 20:1-21*

## **Additional Notes**

Perhaps you’ve been given a command or order in the past by someone and your immediate response was “Who sez so!?” And it matters – really matters “Who sez so!” In this passage, “\_\_\_\_\_” sez so! (vss 1-2 – the \_\_\_\_\_ of this passage!)

**Situation analysis – What had gone on that led to Exodus 20?**

## **The 10 “Words” or Commandments**

### **Commandment #1 (Vs. 3)**

\_\_\_\_\_ worship of Jehovah (YHWH) – no other – \_\_\_\_\_, not \_\_\_\_\_!

What is the application for us, today?

### **Commandment #2 (Vss. 4-6)**

Create no \_\_\_\_\_ of God or object of worship – worship only of the “Invisible God”

What is the application for us today?

### **Commandment #3 (Vs. 7)**

Prohibits the \_\_\_\_\_ use of God’s “name” (esp. YHWH).

### **Commandment #4 (Vss. 8-11)**

Keep the “Sabbath Day” \_\_\_\_\_ for God (i.e. keeping it \_\_\_\_\_). Cease work on the 7<sup>th</sup> day.

**Commandment #5 (Vs. 12)**

“ \_\_\_\_\_ ” your parents (and elders). A Command with a  
“ \_\_\_\_\_ ” (Eph. 6:1-2)

What is the application for us today?

**Commandment #6 (Vs. 13)**

Never “ \_\_\_\_\_ ” a fellow human being.

What is the application for us today?

**Commandment #7 (Vs. 14)**

Never commit “ \_\_\_\_\_ ” – violating your marriage vows or  
the marriage vows of another (cp. Matt. 19:3—9; 5:28)

What is the application for us today?

**Commandment #8 (Vs. 15)**

Never take \_\_\_\_\_ to another – stealing or theft (cp. Ex. 22:1-5)

What is the application for us today?

**Commandment #9 (Vs. 16)**

Do not be guilty of “false witness” ( \_\_\_\_\_ )

What is the application for us today?

**Commandment #10 (Vs. 17)**

Prohibits an \_\_\_\_\_ that leads to \_\_\_\_\_... desiring  
to have what belongs to another (cp. 1 Tim. 6:6-9; Heb. 13:5)
